- setting objectives and targets on health and safety issues.
- conducting annual managerial reviews of our progress.
- ensuring adequate resources are available to fulfil this policy.

We aim to achieve these objectives through risk assessment and by implementing appropriate controls. We require that as an integral part of our processes, all our businesses be operated and managed so as to ensure a high level of protection for the health and safety of our employees, contractors, customers, the public and the environment. We shall continue to integrate health and safety considerations into our business operations.


Responsibilities are defined throughout the organisation. Managerial and supervisory roles are responsible for implementing the defined safety arrangements for the areas and activities under their control. The effective implementation of this policy requires the co-operation and active involvement of employees at all levels and in all areas.

Employees are required to:

- co-operate with the company to ensure compliance with applicable statutory requirements by working in accordance with the safety management system and standard operating procedures.
- work safely to ensure their health and safety and that of any persons who could be affected by their acts and omissions.
- report any areas where the existing safety arrangements fail to reduce risks to an acceptable level.

The CEO, supported by the senior management, is responsible for implementing and reviewing this policy and monitoring the company's health and safety performance.
